Reverend Dr. Howard John Wesley represents the fourth generation of Baptist preachers in his family. This native of Chicago is the son of the late Rev. Dr. Alvin J. Wesley and Dr. Helene J. Wesley. Rev. Wesley acknowledged and accepted his calling into the Gospel ministry at the age of sixteen and was licensed to preach in 1989. He was ordained in 1997 at his father's church, the Hermon Baptist Church in Chicago, Illinois by the Greater New Era Baptist District Association of the Baptist General State Convention of Illinois. He has also served on the staff of the Orange Grove Baptist Church of Durham, NC and the Concord Baptist Church of Boston, MA.

Dr. Wesley is a 1994 magna cum laude graduate of Duke University where he doubled majored in Biomedical and Electrical Engineering. After his first year in medical school, he yielded to God's call once again and walked away from a medical career to attend seminary in preparation for serving God's people. He attended the Boston University School of Theology where he was a Martin L. King, Jr. Scholar and a 1997 summa cum laude graduate concentrating on Biblical Studies and African-American religious history.

His passion for preaching and learning led him to the Associated Chicago Theological School's Doctor of Ministry in Preaching Program where he graduated from the Northern Baptist Theological Seminary with his Doctor of Ministry degree in 2003. His thesis, "Prescriptive Preaching: Effective Homiletical Methodology for the Next Generation of Black Churchgoers" is now being prepared for publication. Rev. Wesley has also completed post-doctoral studies at Oxford University in Oxford, England and has served as an adjunct professor of homiletics at Boston University and an adjunct professor of church administration at Hartford Seminary.

In 1997, God called Rev. Wesley to the historic St. John's Congregational Church in Springfield, Massachusetts. By the grace of God, under Rev. Wesley's faithful and committed leadership and through his passionate and loving spirit, he led St. John's into a period of unprecedented growth, as the church grew from fewer than 200 to nearly 3,000 members with three Sunday services, two weekly Bible studies, daily prayer hours, and over 35 active ministries.

He is passionate about proclaiming the Good News of Jesus Christ, making the Word of God relevant in the lives of believers, and building the Kingdom of God in the congregation and community. He is currently leading Alfred Street Baptist Church in participation with the National Baptist Convention, USA, Inc., National Baptist Congress of Christian Education, Progressive National Baptist Convention, Baptist World Alliance, the Lott Carey Baptist Foreign Convention, the Northern Virginia Baptist Association and the Baptist General Convention of Virginia. He is highly sought after and preaches at revivals, conferences, and church growth seminars across the nation and lectures annually at the National Baptist Congress. Dr. Wesley was the keynote speaker for the People's Inaugural Project Prayer Breakfast for President Barack Obama.

Now a resident of Alexandria, Virginia, he is associated with the Alexandria NAACP, the Northern Virginia Urban League, the Community Coalition for Haiti, a member of the Board of Directors for the Hopkins House and the Institute for Responsible Citizenship. He has also served as honorary chairperson for the African American Adoptions, Inc.

For his labor Rev. Wesley has received numerous awards and accolades, including being recognized by the African American Pulpit as one of the top 20 preachers under forty in the Black Church. He has also received the Alexander Mapp Black Achievement Award (for his work with the school system), the Black Men of Greater Springfield Community Service Award, Brianna Fund for Children with Disabilities recognition, and was recognized and honored four times by the mayor of Springfield for his leadership and community work.

Procedures of Purchasing

In order to maintain accurate records, make ministry purchases more cost efficient and provide a consistent method of making purchases, the following procedures have been implemented:

1. Before making any purchases for your ministry, a Purchase Request form must be submitted to the Trustees (drop off, fax to the church office or place in the Trustees mailbox in the fellowship hall)
2. The form should be submitted 2 weeks prior to the date the funds are needed.
3. You will receive a response from the Trustees within 3-5 days.
4. Upon approval of your request, you will be given a check for the approved amount and provided with the necessary information to avoid paying tax on your purchases.
5. Receipts for all purchases must be returned to the Trustees within 7 days of the event. (if receipts are not returned this will result in a delay in the processing of future ministry requests)
6. The person in whose name the check is issued will be responsible for the return of all receipts and funds not used.
7. On those limited occasions when the ministry cannot wait for funds to be dispensed from the ministry account, both the Pastor and Trustee must grant approval prior to any purchase. Any purchases made without the proper approvals will not be reimbursed. Please use the voucher request for payment when seeking reimbursement. A receipt must be attached and the request must be submitted within seven (7) days of purchase.

Procedures For Feeding the Seniors and Homeless Saturday before the 1st Sunday

1. Select Menu (should include the following)

Meat

Vegetable

Starch

Roll or Corn Bread

Desert

Punch (Inside serving only)

2. Determine who will be responsible for shopping for the food and who will cook food. Example - XYZ will cook 10 pounds of chicken, XYZ will cook 10 pounds of string beans etc. All Food should be prepared in advance if possible.
3. The Ministry leader submit a voucher for shopping in the amount of \$220.00 at least two weeks prior to the feeding date.
4. Check kitchen 2 weeks prior to feeding date to make sure all required/needed material are there i.e., serving platters, plastic bags, dish detergent, paper towels, aluminum foil, etc.
5. Contact the Church Administrator to advise of any needed material.
6. Check to make sure shed is unlocked or supplies needed are in the kitchen.
7. All participants should arrive at the church by 9:00 AM.
8. Packing of bags should be completed by 11:00 AM for distribution.
(Assembly Line Style)
9. Assign persons to set up 4 long tables for approximately 20-30 persons being served in the fellowship hall—(AARP—approximately 5– 20, Walk Ins approximately 5-10) - All subject to change.
10. Inside serving is from 12:00 noon to 1:00 PM.
11. Person will deliver meals (approximately 89-100) to 111 West Street
(Senior Citizen Complex) - Meals to be delivered within the community
(approximately 5-10)
12. Ministry leaders will be given meal distribution list (subject to change at any given time)
13. Leave kitchen clean, bag all garbage.
14. Keep record of meals served.
15. Prepare to serve 150-175 meals is subject to change upon the need.
